- 3.2. The proposed change to the permitted investments of the Fund is required following the Manager's intention to restructure the Fund from an equity fund to a feeder fund.
- 3.3. If passed at the adjourned meeting, this resolution will give the Manager the authority to change the permitted investments of the Fund. Further, the Manager and/or the Trustee will be authorised to do all such things necessary to give effect to the change of permitted investments of the Fund in accordance with the relevant laws, guidelines and provisions of the Deed.
- 4. Consequential / Additional Amendments
- 4.1. In addition to the changes set out in paragraphs 1 to 3 above, the following information in relation to the Fund will also be changed:
 - (a) The name of the Fund will be changed as follows:
 - TA Asia High Conviction Fund
